**REQUEST TO EXECUTE CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH PACIFIC  
GRAFFITI SOLUTIONS FOR ENHANCED GRAFFITI ABATEMENT SERVICE  
IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 11.**

**RECOMMENDATION**

That the Board authorize the Office of Community Beautification to amend the existing graffiti abatement and public right-of-way clean-up contract with Pacific Graffiti Solutions providing an additional \$70,000.

**DISCUSSION**

- The Office of Councilmember Bill Rosendahl has agreed to provide \$45,000 to provide for additional graffiti abatement services in Council District 11 (Council File 09-0011-S48). The Office of Community Beautification is providing the remaining funds to establish an enhanced level of service in portions of Council District 11.
- The Office of Community Beautification was authorized by the Board of Public Works to submit an RFP for graffiti abatement/litter clean-up citywide in March 2008. RFP's were received on May 15, 2008.
- The Council authorized the Board of Public Works, Office of Community Beautification to execute contracts and amendments with graffiti removal contractors to implement graffiti removal and cleanup services (CF 98-1000).
- The source of funding is from the Council District 11 Street Furniture Revenue Account and from the Board of Public Works contractual services account.
