

SECTION 01712 SUBSURFACE DATA

1.1 THE REQUIREMENT

- A. All soil and test hole data, water table elevation, and soil analyses shown on the Drawings or included in the Specifications / Contract Documents apply only at the location of the test holes and to the depth indicated. Test reports for test holes, which have been drilled, are available for inspection at the office of the ENGINEER, or contained in the Geotechnical Report for the project. Any additional subsurface exploration shall be done by the CONTRACTOR at their own expense. The indicated elevation of the water table is that level at the date the test hole data was obtained. It is the CONTRACTOR'S responsibility to determine and allow for the elevation of groundwater at the date of Project construction. A difference in elevation between the ground water shown in soil boring logs and groundwater actually encountered during construction will not be considered as a basis for extra work.
