**White Point Landslide

Bullet Point Update:**

- Los Angeles Fire Department staff conducted an initial inspection of the abandoned Nike missile site on January 18, 2012.
- City of Los Angeles officials and technicians only, cleared for entry to the Nike site.
- February 8, 2012 is the tentative date for the second inspection of the Nike site.
- To date, the slide has shown no movement since the November 20, 2011 landslide event.
- The City continues to monitor survey points around the site on a regular basis.
- The walking trail, next to the chain link fence, was closed on January 24, 2012 because of a rain event.
- The walking trail was opened on January 25, 2012 after the area was inspected.
